NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that THE COMPANY OF PROPRIETORS OF WHITCHURCH BRIDGE (the Company) has applied to the Secretary of State for Transport to increase the Toll Charges at Whitchurch Bridge.

Below are shown the current Toll Charges which the Company is authorised to demand and take, and the proposed Toll charges, including a Toll charge for motorcycles, for which the Company has now applied under Section 6 of the Transport Charges (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1954.

Any person having a substantial interest may, not later than 26th December 2008 (ie within a period of 42 days from the first publication of this Notice), object to this application by giving notice in writing to the Secretary of State for Transport, c/o Julian Smith, Roads Strategy Division, Department for Transport, Zone 3/05, Great Minster House, 76 Marsham Street, London SW1P 4DR, stating the grounds of their objection, and by sending a copy to the Company at the address below. PUBLIC INQUIRY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Local Inquiry will be held by Mr M Heyes, an Inspector appointed for the purpose by the Secretary of State for Transport, beginning at 10 am on Tuesday 2nd June 2009 at The Elephant Hotel, Church Road, Pangbourne, Reading RG8 7AR, in connection with the Application made by the Company of Proprietors of Whitchurch Bridge pursuant to the Whitchurch Bridge Acts of 1792 and 1988 and section 6 of the Transport Charges Etc (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1954 that in the circumstances now existing the tolls authorised to be charged in respect of vehicles passing over Whitchurch Bridge should be revised as follows:

1. Vehicles not exceeding 3.5 tonnes maximum gross weight 40p
2. Vehicles exceeding 3.5 tonnes maximum gross weight £3.00

Tolls will be permitted to be charged for motorcycles.

Please be aware that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it; that it will be passed to the Inspector holding the Inquiry; and that he may be required to disclose at the Inquiry the objection or representation and, unless there are special reasons to the contrary, identify the author.
